**IN THE MARIETTA MUNICIPAL COURT
MISDEMEANOR BOND SCHEDULE**

Pursuant to R.C. Section 2937.011(I)(1), the misdemeanor bond schedule for misdemeanor charges, including traffic offenses, **unless excluded below**, shall be set as follows:

Personal recognizance is the general rule for Ohio Residents (subject to exclusions below).

When the Judge or Magistrate has previously set bail in a case, or has ordered a new amount in its last warrant, that bail shall remain in effect unless otherwise ordered by the Court.

If **any** of the below apply, the defendant is **excluded** from the presumption of receiving a Personal Recognizance bond:

1. Any person charged with offenses of violence as defined in Section R.C. 2901.01(A)(9)
2. The person charged is unable to provide for his/her own safety or requires medical care
3. The person cannot or refuses to offer satisfactory proof of his/her identity and address
4. The person refuses to sign for a personal bond acknowledging their upcoming Court date
5. The person refuses to be booked and processed as required by law
6. The person has an outstanding warrant or a history of warrants being issued for failure to appear for Court appearances
7. The person resisted, fled, or placed/attempted to place a person or officer at risk of harm
8. Misdemeanor charges, regardless of residency and regardless of whether charged under the Ohio Revised Code, local ordinance, or other statutory provision for:
 - A. Domestic Violence or any other offense of violence if the victim is a family or household member (see R.C. 2919.251)
 - B. Violation of any protection order
 - C. Violation of community control or probation
 - D. The following offenses if the accused was subject to a protection order and/or has a prior conviction involving the same complainant/victim, pursuant to R.C. 2903.212: Aggravated menacing (R.C. 2903.21), Menacing by stalking (R.C. 2903.211), Menacing (R.C. 2903.22), Aggravated trespass (R.C. 2911.211), Any sexually oriented offense as defined by R.C. 2950.01
 - E. Any other offense when the victim, police officer, or prosecutor is seeking a protection order, no contact order, or other conditions of bond.
9. Non-waivable criminal and traffic misdemeanors where the accused is a non-resident see current bond schedule, unless the arresting officer reasonably believes that the accused will appear after signing a personal recognizance bond.
10. If the police officer or prosecutor, based on the circumstances of the case, reasonably believes that a personal recognizance bond is insufficient to protect the safety of the community or assure the Defendant's appearance, the *attached form must be completed and provided to the jail and the Court*. Once the form is completed, the conditions of release shall be set pursuant to R.C. Section 2937.011(I)(1) (current bond schedule).

NOTE: The Court will establish bond for ALL felony offenses on a case-by-case basis at Defendant's initial court appearance and SHALL be held in custody WITHOUT bond until said hearing.

NOTE: A \$25.00 surcharge is to be paid on all cash and surety bonds at the time of posting. This is an additional fee imposed by State law. Bond may be posted by cash, surety or credit card.

NOTE: The bond amounts set herein are applicable whenever not otherwise contrary to Ohio law. The arresting agency may hold a defendant when defendant has a record of non-appearance or the law enforcement officer has reason to believe that the amount set forth herein will not secure the defendant's appearance, of there is a concern that violence is imminent.

SCHEDULE OF MISDEMEANOR BONDS – IN CUSTODY

This schedule is published pursuant to R.C. Section 2937.011. The Court will establish bond for felony offenses on a case-by-case basis at arraignment.

For all misdemeanor offenses for which there are currently no specific bonds provided by Court schedule, bonds shall be as follows:

Regardless of Defendant’s residency:

Domestic Violence M-1 and M-4 (2919.25)	Court to set bond
